NAMIBIA

Namibia is the land of deserts, from the Kalahari in the east to the Namib in the west. It has the highest sand dunes in the world and a timeless landscape of shimmering plains and rugged mountains. The many national parks and game reserves host a variety of wildlife, some species specially adapted to the harsh environment. The country is a rich tapestry of cultures and a visit here also offers the opportunity to interact with the indigenous people like the nomadic Himba. It is now possible to cover enormous distances between deserts, dunes and oases by scheduled light aircraft transfers that provide breathtaking views of this extraordinary land from the air.

Highlights

Desolate, stunningly beautiful Skeleton Coast; Sossusvlei sand dunes; Cape Cross Seal Reserve; the rugged wilderness of Etosha and Damaraland; the Namib Desert, home of the Himba people.

Game Viewing

Best during the dry season (May-Oct). Etosha is Namibia's premier wildlife park. In the desert areas you will not find large numbers of animals, but there are rare and interesting species to be found.

Climate

Namibia's climate is the driest in Africa. The cold Benguela current keeps the Namibian coast cool and rainless. Inland rain falls during the summer (Oct-Apr) as thundery showers. Summer days are hot and the nights cool, whilst winters are sunny and cold.

Days 1/2 Sossusvlei

Depart Windhoek by light aircraft to Sossusvlei and transfer to Little Kulala for 2 nights. During your stay, travel to Sossusvlei, home of the highest sand dunes in the world (up to 300m!)

Days 3/4 Damaraland

Depart on a breathtaking flight over Sossusvlei and along the Skeleton Coast where dunes and desert meet the rugged water of the Atlantic Ocean. Lunch is taken in Swakopmund, followed by a boat trip at Walvis Bay, before continuing the journey to the delightful Damaraland Camp or Desert Rhino Camp. Game drives by 4WD in search of the rare and endangered desert elephant and black rhino are a highlight.

Days 5/6 Ongava

Depart Damaraland for the Ongava Game Reserve bordering famous Etosha NP. Daily game drives and walking trails (with armed guide) are offered within the Reserve, as well as excursions into Etosha National Park. Accommodation will be at the intimate Ongava Tented Camp or Ongava Lodge.

Day 7 Safari ends Windhoek

Travel by light aircraft to Windhoek.

Days 1-3 or 1-4 Skeleton Coast

We visit the clay castles of the Hoarusib, the roaring dunes, lichen fields, seal colonies and shipwrecks. An incredible cultural experience is a visit to the Himba people just outside the park.

Day 4 or 5 Safari ends

Fly back to Windhoek Eros airport, tour ends.

Accommodation is in comfortable dome tents featuring stretcher beds, linen, and ensuite shower and toilet. Activities include game drives, scenic walks and mountain biking. The group size is limited to 8 and is led by an experienced licenced guide.

Days 1/2 Sossusvlei

Depart by road to Kulala Adventurer Camp in Sossusvlei, stopping at the Naukluft Mountains enroute. Enjoy exploring the Sossusvlei dunes, scenic drives on the concession and stargazing. LD

Days 3/4 Swakopmund

Travel by road to the coastal town of Swakopmund, renowned for its marine mammals. Enjoy a private cruise (weather permitting) at Walvis Bay to view fur seals and dolphins. Overnight at the historic Hansa Hotel. BLD/BL

Days 5-7 Damaraland

Continue via Cape Cross to Damaraland Adventurer Camp. Enjoy nature walks, mountain biking, viewing the rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, and day and night game drives. BLD

Days 8/9 Etosha

Nambia's big game country: Etosha. Here stay at Andersson's Camp in a private game reserve (Ongava) that borders Etosha National Park. Enjoy game walks, game drives on the property and into Etosha National Park. BLD

Day 10 Safari ends Windhoek

Return to Windhoek by road where the safari ends. B

This safari provides a wonderful insight into Namibia, a remarkable land of deserts, rugged mountains and spectacular wildlife. We visit the sand dunes at Sossusvlei, search for marine life off the coast of Swakopmund, explore the windswept Skeleton Coast, the rugged wilderness of Etosha and Damaraland. The group size is limited to 8 and is led by an experienced guide. Accommodation is mostly in Wilderness Safaris very comfortable permanent tented camps.

Days 1/2 Sossusvlei

Depart by road to Kulala Desert Lodge. On day 2 take an early morning excursion to Sossusvlei, home of the world's highest sand dunes. LD/BLD

Days 3/4 Swakopmund

Travel north-west via the Kuiseb Canyon to visit the extraordinary Welwitschia plants before continuing to Swakopmund. A private boat cruise and seafood lunch at Walvis Bay to see Cape fur seals and dolphins is a highlight of your stay. BLD/BL

Day 5 Damaraland

A long drive (280 km) as we follow the treacherous Skeleton Coast before heading inland to the award winning Damaraland Camp. BLD

Days 6/7 Desert Rhino Camp, Damaraland

Head north to Desert Rhino Camp, situated in the rugged Palmwag concession. This area is home to a growing population of desert-adapted black rhino (the largest concentration in the world outside a national park) which are monitored and protected by the Save the Rhino Trust. BLD

Days 8/9 Central Etosha

Drive 350 km east to Ongava Tented Camp in the Ongava Game Reserve bordering famous Etosha National Park. BLD

Days 10-12 Skeleton Coast National Park

Fly by light aircraft to the spectacular Skeleton Coast, home to sand dunes and windswept plains. Enjoy a visit to a local Himba community, located just outside the park. Accommodation is in comfortable tents at the Skeleton Coast Research Camp. BLD

Day 13 Safari ends Windhoek

Fly back to Windhoek, (approx 16.00) tour ends. B

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day 1 Windhoek

On arrival at Windhoek Airport, collect your hire car. Overnight at the boutique Olive Grove Guesthouse in Windhoek featuring 12 elegant rooms, open-air lounge, spa, plunge pool and tranquil garden.

Days 2/3 Sossusvlei

Drive south to Kulala Desert Lodge located on a 37,000 ha Nature Reserve which stretches from the Namib Desert to the Naukluft Mountains. On Day 3, take an early morning drive to experience the incredible sand dunes of Sossusvlei at sunrise.

Days 4/5 Swakopmund

Self drive to the coastal town of Swakopmund. Overnight in the prestigious Hansa Hotel, renowned for its outstanding cuisine.

Day 6 Damaraland

Drive approximately 4 hours to Doro Nawas with spectacular views of the Etendeka Mountains and the red sandstone cliffs of Twyfelfontein. This intimate camp has 16 permanent canvas and thatch suites. View the fascinating rock paintings and observe local wildlife including the desert-adapted elephant.

Days 7/8 Etosha

After about 3 hours drive, stop for 2 nights at Ongava Lodge on the border of Etosha National Park in a private game reserve.

Activities include game drives in the park to observe wildlife including elephant, rhino, lion, cheetah and springbok.

Day 9 Tour ends Windhoek

Drive back to Windhoek, returning your hire car before your onward flight.
