Join our special escorted departure to East Africa's world-renowned parks during the prime game-viewing month of February. This is when the great migratory herds of wildebeest and zebra dot the Serengeti plains as far as the eye can see. It is also the period of calving; when calves are born en masse to minimize loss to predators. Highlights over the 15-day trip include 2 nights at the exclusive Tortilis Camp in Kenya's Amboseli National Park, 1 night at Lake Manyara, 2 nights at the Ngorongoro Crater and 4 nights at Ndutu Lodge, deep in the heart of the Serengeti.

Day 1 Inflight to Nairobi

Depart Australia on Emirates Airlines to Nairobi via Dubai.

Day 2 Nairobi

On arrival in Nairobi and transfer to the Norfolk Hotel. B

Days 3/4 Tortilis Camp

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Amboseli. Tortilis holds 34 guests in spacious tents set under thatch. Spectacular views of Mt. Kilimanjaro can be seen when conditions are clear. Game drives by open 4WD vehicles on the private concession. BLD

Day 5 Kirurumu Tented Lodge

Morning transfer by road to Arusha for lunch and then to Kirurumu Tented Lodge. Time permitting, we enjoy a game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. BLD

Days 6-9 Serengeti

Drive to the vast plains of the Serengeti, our destination Ndutu Lodge. This comfortable lodge is shaded by giant acacia trees overlooking Lake Ndutu and is the perfect base from which to explore the Serengeti plains. BLD

Days 10/11 Ngorongoro Farmhouse

Transfer by road from the Serengeti to Ngorongoro Conservation area via Olduvai Gorge, the "cradle of mankind". Olduvai is world famous for the archaeological discoveries made there by Dr. Louis and Mary Leakey. On day 11 we visit the Ngorongoro Crater. BLD

Day 12 Nairobi

Transfer by road to Arusha for lunch before our return road journey to Nairobi. Overnight at the Norfolk Hotel. B

Day 13 Inflight to Australia

Morning at leisure. Transfer to the airport for our flight to Dubai. On arrival in Dubai, connect with your return flight to Australia. Note, you may require a short stopover (additional cost) in Dubai depending on the city you are returning to.

Days 14/15 Tour ends Australia

Arrive in Australia where our tour ends.
