Price per person includes: 10 nights' accommodation in moderate/first class hotels and comfortable lodges, 1 dinner, 4 picnic lunches or breakfasts (depending on weather), Jasper tour, Banff tour, hotel pick up and drop off in Vancouver, transportation by air-conditioned minivan and park fees. Maximum 9 passengers.

Discover the pristine lakes, glaciers and towering mountains of the Rockies by minivan. Visit Banff and the Icefields Parkway, beautiful Lake Louise, Glacier National Park, Revelstoke and the historic Okanagan Valley.

Day 1 Vancouver

Arrive at Vancouver Downtown hotel (or similar) for overnight.

Day 2 Kamloops

Depart Vancouver along the scenic Sea to Sky Highway and into the Coast Mountain Range. Stop at Whistler before continuing on to visit Lillooet Band. Overnight at Historic Plaza Hotel or similar.

Day 3 Jasper

Follow the North Thompson River to Clearwater for whitewater rafting or sightseeing in Wells Grey Park. Travel to the Rockies with views of Mt Robson. Overnight at Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge or similar.

Day 4 Banff

Drive the spectacular Icefields Parkway looking out for local wildlife. View the Athabasca and Dome Glaciers as well as Peyto and Bow Lakes. End the day with a tour of Banff where you will overnight.

Banff National Park

Day 5 Banff

Visit beautiful Lake Louise and Moraine Lake. Return to Banff for free time or take an optional tour of Banff including the Banff Springs Hotel, the Cave and Basin or Sulphur Mountain.

Day 6 Revelstoke

Explore the magnificent Glacier National Park with its deep, rugged valleys and the Spiral Railway Tunnels. Continue over historic Rogers Pass and the Columbia Mountains to Revelstoke for overnight.

Day 7 Okanagan

Drive high above the sub alpine tree line to Mt Revelstoke for stunning views and the chance to see early morning wildlife. Then descend to the Okanagan, the 'fruit basket of B.C.'. Overnight in South Kelowna.

Day 8 Penticton

Explore the highlights of the Okanagan, including wineries and the historic trestles of the old Kettle Valley Railroad. Overnight in the Penticton area.

Days 9/10 Vancouver

Return via the Fraser River and the farming areas of the Fraser Delta to Vancouver where day 10 is free to explore. Overnight Vancouver.

Day 11 Tour ends Vancouver

Check out of your hotel. Tour ends.

Day 1 VIA Rail

Make your own way to Vancouver's Pacific Central Station for your journey through the Rockies. Board VIA Rail's "The Canadian" at 20.30 and travel through Fraser Canyon and Hell's Gate. Overnight on board.

Day 2 Jasper

Travel through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains to Jasper. Overnight at a hotel. BL

Day 3 Jasper

Tour by coach through outstanding scenery including Athabasca Canadian Heritage River, Medicine Lake and Maligne Canyon. Overnight Jasper.

Day 4 Banff

Drive the Icefields Parkway through Jasper and Banff National Parks. At Columbia Icefield, tour the Athabasca Glacier on the Brewster Ice Explorer. Brief stop at Lake Louise before continuing onto Banff for overnight.

Day 5 Lake Louise

Tour of Banff and environs, ascend Tunnel Mountain, visit Bow Falls and stroll along Lake Minnewanka. Included is a gondola ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain. Afternoon transfer to Lake Louise for overnight.

Day 6 Kelowna

Travel up to the summit of Glacier National Park following the Canadian Pacific rail line. Stop at Revelstoke for lunch before continuing south to Kelowna for overnight via the town of Armstrong. L

Day 7 Vancouver

This morning enjoy a wine tasting and vineyard tour before carrying on to Minter Gardens for a tasty lunch. Travel through the Fraser River region before returning to Vancouver for overnight. BL

Day 8 Tour ends Vancouver

Tour ends today in Vancouver.

Day 8 Prince George

Early this morning, board VIA Rail's Prince Rupert to Jasper Train for a rail tour of the stunning Skeena River Valley. BLD

Day 9 Jasper

Reboard the train and follow the Fraser River, which cuts through moose and bear country, to the alpine town of Jasper. BL

Days 10/11 Banff

Climb onto Brewster's unique Ice Explorer for a tour of the Athabasca Glacier. Continue on to Lake Louise, "the Jewel of the Rockies" before arriving in Banff. Enjoy a tour of the town and its surrounds.

Day 12 Kelowna

Travel via Lake Louise up to the summit of Glacier National Park following the Canadian Pacific rail line stopping at Revelstoke for lunch. Continue south into the wine region of Okanagan Valley. Overnight in Kelowna. L
