**E**xperience the full length of North America's beautiful Inside Passage between Seattle and Juneau. Cruise by snow-capped mountains, glaciers, waterfalls and tree-lined narrow passageways for close up encounters with bears and other animals foraging along the shoreline. Witness diverse marine life including Orca Whales and abundant bird life. The itinerary also features a visit to Ketchikan to discover the rich, cultural heritage of Alaska's Tlingit Indians. Activities include nature hikes and kayaking excursions.

### SAMPLE ITINERARY (SAFARI QUEST)

**Day 1 Sail from Seattle, Washington**  
Transfer to your motor yacht where you will be welcomed with champagne and hors d'oeuvres. Commence cruising. D

**Day 2 San Juan Islands & Friday Harbour**  
Cruise through the hundreds of untouched islands in the San Juans, followed by a visit to the "boaters'

haven" of Friday Harbour. Visit the Whale Museum, or have a look at the many boutique shops in this tiny town. Depart for Canadian waters, keeping an eye out for Orca Whales along the way before anchoring in a quiet bay for the evening. BLD

### Days 3-6 Canadian Inside Passage

Explore the spectacular waters of the Canadian Inside Passage. Enjoy nature hikes and kayaking excursions into the pristine wilderness, a First Nations dance performance, and possible sightings of Orca Whales, sea lions and bears. Further north, step ashore with naturalists for a presentation on local wildlife studies, including rainforest wolves and the mysterious Spirit Bear. BLD

### Days 7-10 Alaskan Towns and Passages

Discover the cultural heritage of Alaska's Tlingit Indians on a guided tour of Saxman Totem Village in Ketchikan before departing for the open space and solitude of Alaska's waterways. Cruise northward with opportunities to kayak and view eagles, seals, whales and porpoise. In Petersburg, join a local guide for some first-hand stories and experiences of life in this community. BLD

### Days 11/12 Fjords and Hotsprings

Spend three days in the wildest, most pristine corners of Alaska. Paddle kayaks in remote fjords, hike to natural hotsprings, wander through the temperate rainforest of Southeast Alaska, and explore some of the most scenic, hidden gems one can find in the Inside Passage. BLD

### Days 13/14 Glacier Bay National Park

Cruise the spectacular waters of Glacier Bay National Park. Subject to weather conditions, enjoy weaving amongst the icebergs in inflatable zodiacs and kayaking, looking out for puffins, sea lions, mountain goats, bears, moose, eagles, and scenery more spectacular than any place on earth. BLD

### Day 15 Tour ends Juneau

Disembark in Juneau and transfer to the airport or hotel. Tour ends. B

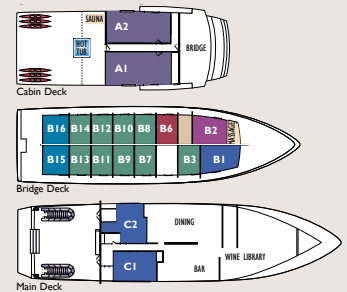

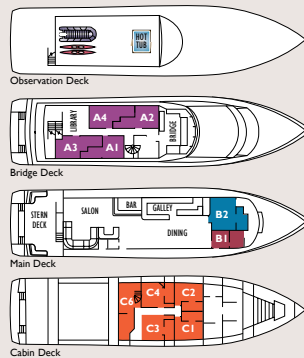

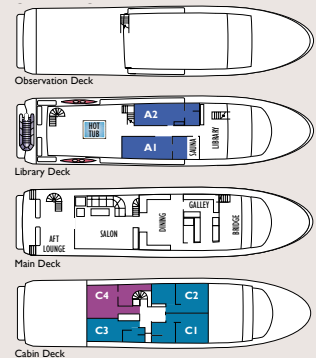

### SAMPLE ITINERARY (SAFARI SPIRIT)

#### Day 1 Juneau

Transfer to your yacht where you will be welcomed with champagne. Commence cruising. D

#### Days 2/3 Glacier Bay National Park

Spend two days exploring the majestic wilderness of the Glacier Bay National Park. Watch for glacier calving (where large chunks of ice fall off). If conditions permit, enjoy kayak trips, inflatable zodiac excursions, or day hikes whilst observing puffins, sea lions, mountain goats, bears, moose, eagles, whales, and some of the most spectacular scenery on earth. BLD

#### Day 4 Icy Strait

Cruise the nutrient-rich waters of Icy Strait in search of Humpback Whales, porpoise, sea lions and other wildlife. Enjoy afternoon skiff or kayak excursions exploring the shorelines of remote bays and visit Point Adolphus, Alaska's most famous Humpback Whale feeding area. BLD

#### Day 5 Frederick Sound

Search for Humpback Whales in the waters of Frederick Sound, take some time out for skiff operations and sea kayaking in Saginaw Bay, and view a sea lion colony at the Brothers Islands. BLD

#### Day 6 Admiralty Island

Explore Gambier Bay by kayak and skiff in search of the huge Brown (Grizzly Bears). Never logged, thick evergreen forest crowds right down to the gravel beaches. Continue on to Wood Spit, keeping an eye out for Humpback Whales. BLD

#### Day 7 Ford's Terror and Endicott Arm

Enjoy views of cliff-walled fjords, snow covered mountaintops and numerous waterfalls as bears amble on the shoreline. Explore Ford's Terror by skiff before anchoring overnight at Taku Harbour to enjoy the Captain's Farewell Dinner. BLD

#### Day 8 Tour ends Juneau

Disembark in Juneau and transfer to the airport or hotel. Tour ends. B

**E**xplore the stunning protected wilderness and waterways of Glacier Bay National Park, a World Heritage Site. Discover 15,000 ft mountains rising straight out of the ocean, come face-to-face with massive glaciers, their blue facades rising some 200 feet above the sea, and experience the thunderous roar of ice as it "calves" into the water. You'll weave into unsung bays and coves where Grizzly Bears raise their young, moose browse among the trees, and mountain goats scale the cliffs above.
