Charming Vancouver

Day 3 Victoria

Drive south via the fishing village of Steveston and visit the restored Gulf of Georgia Cannery. Catch the B.C Ferry from the Tsawwassen Terminal to Vancouver Island. On arrival drive via the famed Butchart Gardens to BC's capital Victoria for overnight.

Day 4 Victoria

Today enjoy a scenic flight over Victoria, the Juan de Fuca Strait and the distant Olympic Mountains.

Days 5/6 Tofino

Travel north along the Island Highway via Chemainus, the 'City of Murals' and the small community of Coombs before entering Cathedral Grove – a preserved old growth rainforest. Visit the Maclean Mill historic site before arriving in beautiful Tofino at the edge of the Pacific Rim National Park. On day 6 enjoy a boat trip via Clayoquot Sound to experience the Hot Springs at Sharps Point (included).

Days 7/8 Campbell River

Depart for Campbell River, Salmon fishing capital of Canada, and spend an afternoon exploring the town. On day 8 board a zodiac for an Orca whale watching tour through the Johnstone Strait (includes lunch). L

Days 9/10 Tour ends Vancouver

Return to Vancouver via the B.C. Ferry from Nanaimo. Next day return your rental car. Tour ends.

Price per person includes: Coach transfer from Victoria to Port McNeill, accommodation with meals as per itinerary, day excursion to Telegraph Cove including a 3.5 hr whale watching trip, full day Grizzly Bear viewing at Knight's Inlet, entrance to U'Mista Cultural Centre, transfer from Port McNeill to Port Hardy, air transfer from Port Hardy to Vancouver.

Not included: Ferry to/from Alert Bay (approx \$9 CAD one-way), arrival taxi's in Alert Bay (approx \$5 CAD one-way) optional activities and gratuities.

Explore the pristine waters of Johnstone Strait, home to the largest population of Orcas in the world. Go Grizzly Bear viewing in Knight Inlet, renowned for its bears, marine wildlife and scenery.

Day 1 Alert Bay

Depart Victoria for Alert Bay and check into Four Room Ocean View Inn. D

Day 2 Alert Bay

The day is free to explore Alert Bay. Highlights include Cormorant Island, U'Mista Cultural Centre, the Ecological Gardens, Big Tree Trail and whale watching. B

Day 3 Alert Bay

Cruise on Johnstone Strait, searching for Orcas, Minke Whales, Pacific White Sided Dolphins, and other marine wildlife. Look out for Black Bear, deer and cougar on the shore. B

Day 4 Alert Bay

Full day tour by boat to Knight Inlet, famous for its Grizzly Bears, beautiful scenery and marine life. Paddle or motor quietly around the estuary, where Grizzly Bears feed on the sedges and grasses. BL

Day 5 Tour ends Vancouver

After breakfast transfer to Port Hardy Airport for afternoon scheduled flight to Vancouver. Tour ends. B

While at Clayoquot enjoy both guided and unguided activities including paddling, biking and hiking. This region is home to prolific wildlife including bears, puffins and porpoises. You are also invited to take part in environmental programs funded by the resort.

Day 1 Wilderness Outpost

Glide across whale rich waters to bathe in the geothermal pools of Hot Springs Cove. Later, embark on a guided hike through ancient forests.

Day 4 Tour ends Vancouver

After breakfast return to Vancouver. Tour ends.

The lodge floats on the edge of a sheltered cove and can only be reached by boat or plane. Choose from a range of outdoor guided activities and enjoy gourmet meals, picnics, and facilities such as sauna, steam room, jacuzzi and plunge pool.

Enjoy guided wilderness activities depending on the season. Travel by boat or on foot to the best wildlife viewing spots.
