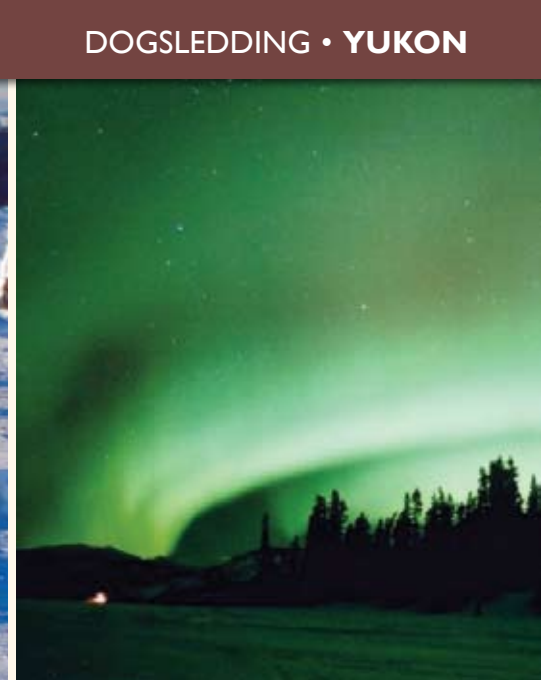

HUSKY ADVENTURE TRAIL

8 days/7 nights

Dog mushing/Ranch/Trapper tents
Departs Sat & Wed ex Whitehorse

Departs: Sat & Wed from 16 Nov 2011 - 13 Apr 2012

Tour cost per person: \$2267
Single room in Whitehorse supp \$161

Price per person includes: Transfer from and to Whitehorse, 1 night accommodation in Whitehorse (room only), accommodation in cabins (shower in main lodge) or heated tent outpost camp (no showers) on a full board basis including non-alcoholic beverages, meals as specified in itinerary, use of personal sled and 3 to 6 Huskies, winter boots, all other equipment see below. Maximum 6 participants per musher guide.

Equipment Hire: \$135 CAD approx payable locally. We can arrange the hire of specific winter gear, including jackets, pants and sleeping bag.

On this unique and exhilarating wilderness experience you will drive your own dog team and be taught all aspects of mushing. It is a challenging but fun adventure! You will need to be physically active, enjoy working with dogs and have a good team spirit.

Day 1 Sky High Valley Ranch

Transfer from Whitehorse to the ranch. Meet your dogs and learn the basics of dogsledding. Dinner and overnight in cosy log cabins or room in lodge. LD

Day 2 Sky High Valley Ranch

Today is a fairly easy day with the chance to get to know your dogs. Cover about 35 km before returning to the ranch for overnight. BLD

Day 3 Sky High Valley Ranch

The dogs will pull you on a trail east of the ranch towards MacIntyre Mountain. Witness amazing views of the Coastal Mountains before returning to the lodge for overnight. BLD

Day 4 Sky High Valley Ranch

Head west towards beautiful Bonneville Lakes on narrower trails with challenging ups and downs. Experience nature as never before as you feel the running rhythm of your team. You will easily cover 20 to 30 kms before returning to the lodge for overnight. BLD

Days 5/6 Wilderness Camp

Head out into the real wilderness for 2 days of unforgettable adventure. The trail follows Fish Lake and heads into the Coastal Ranges, before arriving at a trapper's wall tent camp at Dry Creek where you will spend the next 2 nights. On day 6 travel above the tree line to Ptarmigan Flats with the hope of seeing large flocks of these birds, before returning to the tent camp. BLD

Day 7 Whitehorse

Final day of mushing to return to Sky High Valley Ranch and a sad farewell to your new dog friends. Afternoon transfer to hotel in Whitehorse. BL

Day 8 Tour ends Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport where your tour ends.

Please Note: The itinerary may change due to weather conditions, extreme temperatures or illness of the dogs.

AURORA BOREALIS

4 days/3 nights

Price per person includes: Transfers to and from Whitehorse airport to hotel, 3 nights accommodation on a full board basis, tea & coffee, winter clothing package, Aurora viewing from the hotel and daytime activities.

Thrill to the sight of the spectacular Aurora Borealis or Northern Lights during winter at beautiful Marsh Lake, far from city lights. Just 55 kms south of Whitehorse, the Inn on the Lake is a cosy log cabin retreat with a European flair. Featuring 15 cosy rooms and suites, the Inn offers gourmet meals and a wealth of winter outdoor activities from dog sledding and snow mobiling to fishing and hiking.

Day 1 Marsh Lake
Transfer from the airport to the Inn on the Lake at Marsh Lake (40 mins). The inn is renowned for its gourmet meals and fresh locally sourced food, and has even hosted Martha Stewart. After a delicious dinner go down to the lake shore for amazing skies lit by the Northern Lights. Or watch the lights from the outdoor sauna and hot tub.

Days 2/3 Marsh Lake
Over the next two days enjoy some of the spectacular winter activities offered: drive a dog sled, toboggan, fish for trout and smoke your catch, explore the forest trails by snowshoe, cross-country skis or snow mobile. Or take an optional flight seeing tour over the glaciers and mountains. After the day's adventures relax with a drink on the deck or lounge by the fire in the Great Room before dinner.

Day 4 Tour ends Whitehorse
After a relaxing breakfast transfer back to Whitehorse airport. Tour ends.
