### Day 1 Cairo

Met on arrival at Cairo Airport and transfer to your hotel for 3 nights.

### Day 2 Cairo

Depart early on a full day tour of the Pyramids at Giza, the Sphinx, the ancient royal city of Memphis and the necropolis of Sakkara. Return to your hotel for overnight. BL

### Day 3 Cairo

Depart on a full day tour visiting the magnificent Egyptian Museum and the main sites of Islamic Cairo including the Citadel, the Mosque of Sultan Hassan and the Khan Khalili Bazaar. BL

### Day 4 Nile Cruiser, Luxor

Morning flight to Luxor and transfer to your Nile cruiser. Afternoon tour of the magnificent Karnak and Luxor temples. Overnight on board. BLD

### Day 5 Nile Cruiser, Luxor

Cross the Nile to Thebes Necropolis on the West Bank for a tour of the Valley of the Kings, including the tombs of Seti I and Tutankhamun, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the Valley of the Queens, the Colossi of Amenhotep III (Memnon), the tombs of the Nobles, the Ramasseum and the workers village of Deir el Medina. Afternoon sailing to Edfu via Esna. BLD

**Day 6 Nile Cruiser, Aswan**

Explore Edfu including the well preserved Temple of Horus before cruising to Kom Ombo, an unusual double temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris. Continue sailing on to Aswan for overnight. BLD

**Day 7 Nile Cruiser, Aswan**

Go ashore in Aswan for a tour of the famous Aswan High Dam which controls the Nile River and forms the huge reservoir of Lake Nasser. Continue to the North Quarry with its giant Unfinished Obelisk still embedded in the rock. Next take a boat trip to the beautiful Temple of Isis on Philae Island. In the afternoon enjoy a relaxing cruise to Elephantine Island (once Lord Kitchener's Island) and wander in the exotic botanical gardens. BLD

**Day 8 Cairo**

Disembark after breakfast with an option of visiting the awe-inspiring Temple of Abu Simbel by air (see pg 20). Afternoon flight to Cairo and transfer to your hotel. B

**Day 9 Tour ends**

Transfer to Cairo Airport. Tour ends. B

### Day 7 Edfu

Sail to Edfu. Early evening visit to the Temple of Edfu, the best preserved temple of the ancient world dedicated to Horus the Falcon God. BLD

### Day 8 Aswan

A leisurely sail to Aswan and lunch before a tour of the High Dam and Philae Temple. Relax on board before dinner. BLD

### Day 9 Aswan

Sail to Kom Ombo and visit the temple dedicated to the Crocodile God Sobek, the God of Fertility and Creator of the World, and Horus the Falcon God. Sail back to Aswan for lunch and a visit to the Botanical Gardens by felucca. Evening Sound and Light Show at Philae Temple. BLD

### Day 10 Aswan

Optional visit to Abu Simbel or relax on board. Evening cocktail reception with entertainment on Mango Island. BLD

### Day 11 Cairo

Disembark after breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight to Cairo. Transfer to Mena House Oberoi for overnight. B

**T**ravel by comfortable cruise ship from Aswan across beautiful Lake Nasser visiting mysterious temples, citadels and the magnificent Temple of Ramses II at Abu Simbel. The Lake, created by the building of the Aswan Dam, covers 500 square kms of the ancient Nile Valley. A salvage operation in 1960 rescued many of the most precious archaeological remains and rebuilt them on the lake shore. The 5 day itinerary travels at a more leisurely pace.

## 5 DAY/4 NIGHT ITINERARY

### Aswan to Abu Simbel

#### Day 1 Aswan

Arrive in Aswan and board your cruise ship. Lunch on board. Afternoon visit to the Roman Temple of Kalabsha, the rock-cut temple of Beit El Wali and the Roman Kiosk of Kertassi. Dinner and overnight on board in Aswan Harbour. LD

#### Day 2 Cruising

Sail to Wadi El Seboua and celebrate with a cocktail as you pass the Tropic of Cancer. Dinner and overnight on board. BLD

#### Day 3 Cruising

After breakfast visit the temple of Wadi El Seboua, the Meriotic temple of Dakka, and the unfinished Serapis temple of Meharakka. Afternoon tour of the temple of Amada, the rock-cut temple of Derr and the tomb of Penout. Dinner and overnight on board at Amada. BLD

#### Day 4 Cruising

View the ancient fort of Kasr Ibrim from the ship's deck (entrance to the site is not permitted). Continue sailing to Abu Simbel to visit the two magnificent temples built by Ramses II. Optional Sound & Light show at Abu Simbel (ticket not included). Candlelight dinner on board and overnight at Abu Simbel. BLD

#### Day 5 Tour ends

After breakfast you have the option to return to Abu Simbel for sunrise (ticket not included). Disembark at Abu Simbel for flight back to Aswan. B
