Whilst this tour concentrates on wildlife, it also includes many places of historical, cultural and architectural interest.

Day 1 Delhi

Depart Australia on Singapore Airlines to Delhi. Arrival transfer to Svelte Hotel & Personal Suites.

Day 2 Jaipur

Half day tour of Old Delhi including the vibrant Chandni Chowk bazaar and Jamma Masjid, the largest mosque in Asia. Return to the hotel for lunch followed by a coach transfer to Jaipur (5.5 hrs). Overnight at Le Méridien. BLD

Day 3 Jaipur

After breakfast view the Palace of Winds en route to visit the imposing Amber Fort. Continue on to the City Palace, Jantar Mantar (Observatory), and enjoy a walk through the busy market area of the Old City. Overnight at Le Méridien. BLD

Day 4 Bharatpur

Drive to Bharatpur (4.5 hrs) to explore the World Heritage Site of Keoladeo National Park, an avian paradise with over 375 species of birds. Overnight at The Birder's Inn. BLD

Day 5 Agra

Depart by road to Agra (3 hrs) via the 16th century Mughal city of Fatehpur Sikri. Afternoon tour of Agra Fort followed by a sunset visit to the beautiful Taj Mahal. Overnight at Trident Hotel. BLD

Day 6 Khajuraho

Journey by train to Jhansi and then by road to Khajuraho. Visit the site of one of the oldest temple complexes in India, dating back to 930AD. Overnight at Ramada Hotel. BLD

Days 7-9 Bandhavgarh

Early departure by road for Bandhavgarh National Park (5.5 hrs). Over 3 full days we search for tigers travelling by 4WD jeep on our morning and afternoon excursions. Subject to approval by the park's authorities, we may enjoy a short excursion to view tigers by elephant back. Tiger sightings, however, are not guaranteed. Other wildlife includes rhesus macaque and black faced langur monkeys, chital and sambar deer. Accommodation at King's Lodge. BLD

Days 10-11 Kanha

Drive through farmland and forests to Kanha National Park (5 hrs) for 2 days of tiger tracking. Enjoy morning and afternoon excursions by 4WD and possibly by elephant back. The park is home to a variety of animals including deer, guar, wild dogs and jackals. Overnight at The Baagh Resort. BLD

Day 12 Nagpur

Morning visit to the National Park followed by lunch. Afternoon departure for Nagpur (5 hrs). Overnight at The Pride Hotel. BLD

Day 13 Delhi

Following breakfast you will be transferred to the airport for the flight to Delhi. Arrival transfer to Svelte Hotel & Personal Suites. Afternoon free for optional shopping or orientation tour. BLD

Day 14 Inflight to Australia

Enjoy a morning sightseeing tour of New Delhi, including Qutab Minar tower, Humayun's Tomb, India Gate and Parliament House. Afternoon at leisure for last minute shopping or relaxing at the hotel. Early group dinner before late evening transfer to airport for our flight to Australia. BD

Arrive Australia where our tour ends.

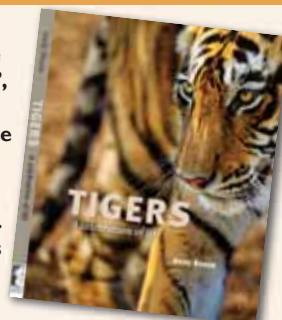
