Day 1 Delhi

Morning visit to the Amber Fort followed by an afternoon city tour of Jaipur including City Palace, Jantar Mantar Observatory and Hawa Mahal. B

Day 5 Agra

Drive to Agra (7 hrs) via Fatehpur Sikri - a beautifully preserved ghost city. The UNESCO World Heritage Site was constructed by Mughal Emperor Akbar in 1570 and served as the capital from 1571 until 1585. Afternoon at leisure. B

Day 6 Tour ends Delhi

Early morning visit to the magnificent Taj Mahal (closed Fri). Visit 16th century Agra Fort built by the great Emperor Akbar, a masterpiece of design. Drive back to Delhi (5 hrs) stopping en route to visit Akbar's tomb at Sikandra. Tour ends. B
